

Shipping Charges For Two-Dimensional Art Only

For three-dimensional art, sitter must contact the artist/seller.

For two-dimensional artwork -- Use the procedures and chart, below.

Call the artist/seller. Encourage the use of the chart below if the artist does not know or have a way to respond quickly; a delay may lose the sale.

Use the chart below if the seller is not available or is otherwise not able to give a specific shipping cost figure.

Measuring the size -- *Add 2 inches to both length and width for packing.*

Use the chart below; find the closest size and then cost of shipping.
(The longer dimension is the more important one.)

All estimates assume UPS boxes, wraps, and insures the art to one of the categories below.

**Oversize: Greater than 32 x 40 (either dimension) --
Sitter must contact artist.**
